Electrical and electronic equipment

The directive 2012/19/EU of the European Parlament and of the Council of 4 July 2012 on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) is intended to prevent the production of waste electrical and electronic equipment and, in addition, to reduce the disposal of waste by re-using, recycling and otherwise recovering such wastes.

Do not dispose of electrical and electronic equipment as household waste.

In accordance with the European Directive, electrical and electronic equipment that is no longer usable must be collected separately and recycled in an environmentally sound manner.

Batteries and accumulators

The directive 2006/66/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 6 September 2006 on batteries and accumulators and waste batteries and accumulators, the so-called Battery Directive, forms the framework for national laws within the EU.

The main objective of this directive is to minimize the impact of batteries and spent batteries on the environment, thus contributing to the protection, preservation and improvement of the quality of the environment.

Concerning the placing on the market, the return and the environmentally sound disposal of batteries and accumulators, please respect the legal regulations in your country that transpose the directive into national law.

Included in the scope of delivery of our devices are batteries and accumulators required for operation.

Do not dispose of batteries or accumulators as household waste.

In accordance with the European Directive, used or defective batteries or accumulators must be collected separately and recycled in an environmentally sound manner.
